With the gentle, cool breeze, clear blue skies, and lush green mountains, there has never been a better time to go out for a round of golf at Toscana Valley Country Club. The course was designed by Bob McFarland, an American golf course architect, who has worked on several projects in many regions around the world. Toscana Valley Country Club is a standard 18-hole course, covering about 400 hectares of land against a stunning backdrop of lakes, a mountain range and the Italian-Tuscan architecture, not to mention all kinds of facilities from restaurant, driving range, badminton court, to fitness center. Today, we have the honor to welcome an acclaimed Thai professional golfer Raththee “Pro Team” Sirithanakunsa, a gold medalist in the 2007 SEA Games, and after a round with him on the course, we sit down to talk about his life and tips on how to improve one’s performance in golf.

Q: Could you introduce yourself to our readers?

A: Hi, I’m Pro Team. My previous name was Pipat Pongnaewsuk, then I changed it to Raththee Sirithanakunsa. I’m from Prachinburi. I started playing golf when I was 14. Now I’m 28, so I have been in this career for about 12 years. Some major awards I have won include 2 gold medals in 2007 SEA Games in Thailand, both in singles and teams. Then I turned pro in 2010.

Q: How did you come into golf career at the first place?

A: Actually, no one in my family plays golf. Back then I usually watched sports like soccer and golf on TV, but that was that. At first, I wasn’t into golf when because it was hard to figure out its scoring system. One day I went to a shopping mall with my family. I asked my mom to buy me a scooter but she refused, so I asked for a miniature golf

club for kids instead and she agreed. I got back, started playing with it and found out I enjoyed the game tremendously. But I didn't know of any golf courses anywhere back then, so I went out hitting a table tennis ball in our lawn. Then I bought real golf clubs and started practicing by myself for a while before having a professional golf instructor. I participated in tournaments. The challenges to me are fun and exciting. Besides, I won trophies, which urged me to practice harder and harder until I got into the Thailand's national golf team when I was 17 years old. In the 2007 SEA Games team, there were Kiradech Apibarnrat, Thanyakorn Khrongpha, Warut Chomchalaem and me. We won gold medals both for teams and singles. It made me feel ready to turn pro so, I became a pro golfer 2 years later. I have been competing in various tournaments to gain experience since I was 23 on until now. During the

last 5 years, I won some professional tournaments including the first Boonchu Ruangkit Championship in collaboration with Asian Tour Development; and the 2017 Thailand PGA Tour hosted by Thailand Golf Association at Suvarnabhumi. I am now participating in PGA Tour Series China collaborating with Web.com. So if I make it to the top 5 in Web.com, I will earn the right to play in North America. That is my goal this year.

Q: Which is the award for which you are proudest?

A: I'm actually proud of every win. Even in some tournaments where I ended up as the runner-up, I'm still proud of my performance because I felt I did very well. But the proudest one, which brought me back to my golf career, was probably the Boonchu Ruangkit Championship. It was the first championship that makes me feel I can still compete



with others, it makes me keep practicing. Anyway, I was still doubtful if it was just mere luck. But after that there came the second and the third wins. So they were the proof I can still compete with others.

Q: Successful as your golf career has been, you have won several trophies. Can you share some tips to be successful in golf, or reducing the score during a round?

A: I used to train so hard and it was completely exhausting. Growing up though, I think, in golf, you cannot just go on a round and expect to land a decent stroke without a good amount of practice. How rigorous is the training? I have to wake up at 6 am to go jogging, go swimming until 8.30 am, then have breakfast. At 9 am I'd be driving in the range until noon. I'd get back to the driving range at 1.30 pm, and at 3 pm I'd practice chipping and putting. The daily



routine goes like this with occasional rounds of golf. The reason I have to train so hard is that golf is my profession. It's a job to me. However, if you train so hard but in the wrong way, your scores could go up. So the tips of everyone in sports career in Thailand, as far as I experienced from senior sportspersons, is that you train correctly with an instructor who knows what he or she is doing.

Q: Is this your first time golfing in Toscana Valley Club? How do you feel?

A: This is my first time on the course. Its reputation preceded it though that it is a very scenic course but I hadn't had a chance to come earlier. I often take part in foreign competitions so I've seen a lot of perfect courses suited for tournaments, and right at the first hole I saw that this course is in a very good condition, from the green,

the fairway, to the challenging architecture; everything is ready for a major competition to be organized here. Playing along the course, I felt it still has far more to offer. The course is not so difficult that it distract or discourage golfers, but at the same time it has a lot of challenges waiting for you. The sceneries here are exceptional. I felt as if I was somewhere abroad. The greens here are mountainous, with various levels of slopes. If anyone wants to go for a round in a course that is manageable and challenging at the same time, I think Toscana Valley Country Club will be among the top list in Thailand.



Q: Are there any holes that you feel particularly impressive or challenging?

A: Honestly, I like every hole. But the notable feature of Toscana Valley Country Club would be the hole with Toscana Tower at the front. If you arrive at the hole without taking any photos, it'd be like you haven't made it to Toscana Valley Country Club at all.

Q: Can you give some tips and tricks in playing a round here at Toscana Valley Country Club? Like how to get a good score here?

A: At first I was not used to the course, so I played along the obvious way to go without many extraordinary angles. The more I create the chance for myself, the more likely I will get a good score. The putting here is decisive for your score, so the initial serve is very important. Make sure you make it on the fairway and create the chance for yourself

to putt. By this way, I think it is positive you get a nice score every time. But I have to warn you that there are holes that would treat you well and some that would punish you, so you'll have to make a play in the former, while creating your own chance for putting in the latter.

Q: Lastly, do you have anything to say to the readers who want to take on the challenges offered by the course at Toscana Valley Country Club?

A: The course is very challenging and the atmosphere and sceneries would make you feel like you're golfing abroad. Apart from that, I can ensure you there are only a few golf courses in Thailand where the grass and the green are of consistent quality in every hole like they are here. So, I'd like to invite everyone who wants to try playing in a mountainous course with foreign vibe, Toscana Valley Country Club would make a perfect choice.

said Mrs. Kannikar Chalitaporn, former President of Siam Commercial Bank a well-known figure in the marketing and advertisement industry, who owns a cozy house in Toscana Valley. We have the pleasure to step inside her home and engage in a casual conversation about what's going on in Toscana Valley, as well as to hear her share some of her secrets in managing life and work.

Professionally, Mrs. Kannikar is among the top executives in terms of Thailand's banking and marketing industry. She honed her skills working in marketing for Unilever



before she was appointed as the President of Siam Commercial Bank until 2015. She is recognized for having revolutionized the banking section in Thailand by incorporating new ideas into personal customer section, focusing on the service provided. Now, even though she has retired, with her expertise, she still holds several significant positions in leading Thai companies including Director, Member of the Executive Committee of Siam Commercial Bank, Vice Chairman of Osotspa Co., Ltd. and Chairman of the board of Index Living Mall Co., Ltd.

Considering all your achievements, we'd like to know more about your work philosophy and how you strike a balance between life and work.

When it comes to work, the most important thing for me is you must love your job. You must enjoy it and you'll



never ever dread the coming of another Monday since you'll be eager to work even if it's Monday. Personally, I can keep working for hours, even a dozen of hours straight, but I have never brought the work home. Throughout my 40-something-year career, I scarcely work when I'm home unless it is really urgent. I have the spheres of my life at home and at work clearly separated.

What are the favorite activities that you engage in when you have free time?

I try to keep Friday, Saturday, and Sunday free of work to hang out and relax with my family either in Khaoyai or Huahin. It's like rebooting yourself for work, especially now when the air in Bangkok is very polluted, hanging out at Khaoyai with friends is a kind of refreshment for your lungs.



How did you come to learn about Toscana Valley?

Actually, I have another house in Khaoyai at 16th km. on Thanarat Road. But after my children came for a round of golf here at Toscana, they brought me to take a look inside because they found it so beautiful here. I knew later that they wanted it so badly, and there happened to be a plot of land close to the restaurant and Town Square that was vacant. It was just in walking distance and I thought it would be a healthy exercise for me to walk there from the house. So I decided to buy it right then.

Which part of Toscana Valley do you find most attractive?

I have seen houses in a lot of development projects, but here at Toscana all the houses are built in the same style. It feels just like I'm in Italy. The space is also open and the facilities here are incredible. There are activities for my grandchildren, like cycling or badminton. The backyard of the house provides enough space for a vegetable gardens, so I'll have an activity to enjoy with my grandchildren. I have grown to love it even more after my stay here because the air is wonderfully fresh — way cleaner than that around my previous house at the 16th km. as the landscape here consists of massive, windblown mountain range. Many say that summer at Khaoyai is very hot, but that's actually far from true. During the day it's hot of course, just like anywhere else. But when the sunlight dims down as the day ends, it gets cooler immediately. In fact, it is 2-3 degrees cooler in Toscana than outside.

Why did you decide to build a house with Toscana Valley?

Because I like the location and my children like it too, which makes the decision making a lot easier. From my experience in building houses in Bangkok and Hua Hin, I saw clearly what it was that I wanted in this one. With the collaboration between my interior designers and Toscana's architect, with ample discussion before the construction, there were only a few details left to be fixed when it actually happened.

From the outside, your house seems to be so lush with all the flowers and trees you have planted. So with regard to the interior, how does the house look inside and what is the style of its decoration?

The house is 3-storey but if you look from the outside it'll appear like a 2-storey house, as when you drive in, you'll land on the second floor. Upon entering the house you'll see the drawing room, the dining room, the kitchen, and the activity area. There is no Thai-style kitchen. Instead, I have only a western pantry kitchen. Every area is designed to connect with each other, while it is still possible to partition them out into rooms. The decoration is simple in cozy brown tone, which is always lovely to look at. And there's a fountain because I like its soothing sound.

Inside, you will find the bedrooms on the first and third floor, so that everyone has to walk only one floor up or down. There were only five bedrooms in the initial design, but eventually we have seven. The initial plan was to build





a massage room upstairs, but on the second thought, it wouldn't be of frequent use, so we changed it to a bedroom. There is also another room over the garage which was supposed to be a maid's quarters, but then one day my sister-in-law walked in and said the scenery from that room is amazing, so we turned it into a bedroom, and it is the most popular guest bedroom because the view of the golf course from the room is unobstructed and really panoramic.

Which is your favorite area of the house?

My favorite area, which, I think, is a very relaxing corner is the pavilion in the yard, especially in the morning when we take our dog out for a walk, drink some coffee, take in the mountain view and breathe in the fresh air. The air is the best out there at the pavilion. I've been spending more and more of my time in Khaoyai, and I think the weather here is a lot better than most people think. It's perfect for a vacation in every season all year round.

One day in the rainy season, I was sitting inside the pavilion, and I saw a great cloud over the mountain in front of the house. Then it was blown down the slope, floating down to the pavilion. I've never seen anything so majestic in my life, and I hope it happens again. It's a pity I didn't have enough time to take the picture of it.

Lastly, can you share tricks or thoughts that contribute to your success?

I think you must be determined with what you do. You might call me old-fashioned but I don't like the idea of changing jobs so often. You can make career changes and moves, but not too often. Give all of you in that job, and find the balance between work and personal life. It's pointless to be successful in your career when it costs you your personal life. There must be a balance of both sides.

Lastly, I want to say something more about Toscana Valley. It is the place everybody likes to live in, always wants to visit, and enjoy quality family time there. It is not often that one finds a place everyone likes. We haven't spent our holidays anywhere else this year, because when asked where they want to go, my family always answer Toscana Valley. There're lots of activities to do. There's bicycle lane, and the house was considerably spacious, so everyone can have their own private room. That's why everyone is happy at Toscana Valley.

Mrs. Kannikar ended the talk with a contented smile and a glimmer of delight in her eyes. Toscana Valley Miniguide -zine couldn't thank her enough for her kindness in sharing her stories about life, work, home, as well as her happiness in this interview.

Wild life Animal

Khao Yai National Park is home to abundant forests and amazing biodiversity. Visitors can encounter many different species and the deer are one of the first mammals to come out to say hello.

Sambar Deer

Scientific name: Rusa unicolor equinus

Found in tropical rain forests in every region nationwide, sambars are the largest deer in Thailand. Regarding their appearance, they have short, coarse hair of yellowish and reddish brown colors, with the length of 2-4 centimeters. The large slits at the inner corners of both eyes called pre-orbital produce musty odor aimed for communication and territory marking by rubbing it to branches. This glands of stags will dilate in mating season. Sambar stags weigh 250 kilograms in average, with the length from nose to tail of 180-200 centimeters, and the height from ground to shoulder of 140-160 centimeters. The distinctive features of the sambar stags are the 7-10 centimeters of fur around their necks and the 3-branch antlers of 70-80 centimeters. The average female sambars weigh 155 kilograms and attain the height of 120 centimeters.

The abundance of Khao Yai forest allows the sambar deer to live on variety of vegetations including grass, leaves, barks, and bamboo shoots. In general, sambars' stable consist of 60% of leaves, 20% of grass and ground plants and berries. Sambars are known for their dietary flexibility depending on their source of food. Hence, they can be seen in several areas, and visitors to Khao Yai are more than likely to encounter these lovely deer.

This issue of mini guidebook explores the new sample house in Zone 8 of Toscana Valley, surrounded by green mountains and golf course, with an interview with the team of interior designers on the insight of their work. INTRODUCTION & DESIGN CONCEPT

The sample CASA TERRAZA house is located in serene atmosphere near the entrance of the estate, with several facilities such as a golf course, a badminton court, a clubhouse, and the Town Square. It was meant to be a cozy, simple holiday house fitting well with the mountainous sceneries of Toscana Valley.

The total space of 580 square meter in this 2-storey house is divided into 3 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, a living room, a kitchen, a dining room, a swimming pool, a resting pavilion, a maid's room, and a laundry room. The interior is modern with the touch of nature with real wood as main material. The wood is of natural brown complimenting the cozy and friendly atmosphere. Matched in terms of color theme, each room in the house is different with unique design furniture that blends smoothly to the style of the room.

The house is designed to have a high ceiling, giving the open and airy sense. Without doors to separate each zone of the house from one another, there are more space for family activity, with the scenic views of Toscana Valley visible from every room.







MASTER BEDROOM

The significant room of the house is the master bedroom which offers the house's most beautiful view. Upon opening the window, one sees not only a golf court but also mountain view and the home swimming pool. The room still retains the warm brown color but adding to it is the gentleness of light tone furniture and room decors.



TUSCANY PART 2

Italian Life

Florence, or Firenze in Italian, is a trading and financial hub in the Middle Age and is regarded as the center of arts and architecture. Once, this town, situated in Tuscany Region, or Toscana (Italian), was a capital city of Italy. Today, the city is famous for being a home of a countless number of incredible Renaissance artwork. For in every corner of the town lie the masterpieces of world-class artists, every step in Florence is an exclusive encounter with such legendary artists as Michelangelo, Leonardo da Vinci and Botticelli.

For many travelers, their journey may start at the town's train station, Firenze Santa Maria Novella (SMN), from where they hop in the bus*. For those fancy partaking a memorable rendezvous, it is definitely possible since most major attractions are within the walking distance.

Florence Cathedral

As a distinctive spot that attracts every single visitor, Florence Cathedral or The Cattedrale di Santa Maria del Fiore is a Catholic cathedral located at the centre of the old town Florence in Piazza del Duomo. Designed by Arnolfo di Cambio, it was constructed around the end of the 13th century and is today the third largest church, after Rome's St Peter's Basilica and London's St Paul's Cathedral.

*Tips: There are many kinds of bus tickets to purchase:

- A pre-purchase 90-minute ticket costs 1.2 € / 2 € if purchased on the bus
- A 24-hour bus pass costs 5 €
- A 3-day buss pass cost 12 €

The next stop is **Cupola di Brunelleschi**, an octagonal dome of the church, built in 14th century by Filippo Brunelleschi and Lorenzo Ghiberti. For those who want to experience the architecture closely, it is allowed to walk up the dome's 463 stairs. Any visitor who plans to check out the place during festive seasons is advised to spare some time as the queue up to the top could be long. Another nearby major stop is **Baptistry of San Giovanni**, Florence's magnificent ancient cathedral, standing in front of Santa Maria del Fiore. As the most ancient religious place of Florence, all Catholics in the town were baptized behind the door of this church. Even now, on every first Sunday of the month, there are still a lot of small babies being baptized here.



Giotto's Bell Tower

One other place of interest is indeed **Giotto's Bell Tower**, one of the four major monuments of Piazza del Duomo Square. It is regarded as the most beautiful bell tower in Italy with its 14th century-styled Gothic exterior architecture. Here, through its 414 stairs, visitors can go up the top to enjoy the beauty of the place and the view of Florence.

All of the three places are located right around Piazza del Duomo. Around and in Florence, there are still more artworks to see and more architectural attractions waiting for visitors to experience and absorb the aesthetic civilization and beauties conjured by the hands of the world-renowned Italian artists.






